INGREDIENTS

Diclofenac potassium 25mg per soft gel capsule

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Adults and children over 14 years: Take 1 capsule every 4-6 hours as required with a drink of water. Do not take more than 3 capsules in 24 hours.

PRECAUTIONS/WARNINGS

Do not use Inflamax Liquid Caps 25 in children under 14 years of age and if the patient has a stomach ulcer or other stomach disorders, impaired kidney function, heart failure or is allergic to diclofenac, aspirin or anti-inflammatory medicines.

Unless a doctor has advised, Inflamax Liquid Caps 25 should not be used if the patient has asthma, for more than a few days at a time, if they are trying to become pregnant or in the first 6 months of pregnancy. The product should not be used at all during the last 3 months of pregnancy.

Unless a doctor or pharmacist has advised, Inflamax Liquid Caps 25 should not be used with other medicines containing diclofenac, or other anti-inflammatory medicines, or other medicines being taken regularly.

Whilst taking the medicine, if an allergic reaction occurs, diclofenac treatment must be ceased immediately and the patient should see a doctor intermediately.

The recommended daily dose must not be exceeded as excessive use can be harmful and increase the risk of heart attack, stroke or liver damage.

If symptoms persist or the condition worsens, the patient should consult their doctor or pharmacist.
